Cookies

To make the Online Ordering site work correctly and to give you the best possible experience, we sometimes place small data files called cookies on your device. Most big websites do this too.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as login, language, font size and other display preferences) over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

How do we use cookies?

When you visit our Websites, we may place a number of cookies in your browser. These are known as First Party Cookies and are required to enable to hold session information as you navigate from page to page within the website. For example, we use cookies on our websites to understand visitor and user preferences, such as language, which improves their experience, and track and analyse usage, navigational and other statistical information.

We also use some third-party applications that place cookies in your browser for analytics and targeting so that we can improve our content and report on our performance.

The cookie-related information is not used to identify you personally and the pattern data is fully under our control. These cookies are not used for any purpose other than those described here.
